

## Olcott Caps for Cancer Patients

RJ Trubitt is collecting knitted caps for the [Olcott Center](#). The center provides education and support for cancer patients. The caps are used by patients who have lost their hair because of cancer treatments. Below are the instructions for the caps.

1. Use very soft yarn, such as Soft Secret by Yarn Bee from Hobby Lobby. Round needles are recommended.
2. Cast on 70 stitches.
3. Knit for 10 inches. The bottom will curl up nicely a little.
4. Knit off.
5. Run a thin ribbon around the top edge and pull tight together. It's nice to leave some ribbon hanging down.
6. Sew up any holes at the top of the hat.
